

How to Measure For Your New Countertops

Follow the below steps for an estimate for your countertop project

- Step 1:** Get the necessary supplies – paper, pen, ruler
- Step 2:** Roughly draw the shape of the countertop area (the drawing does not need to be to scale)
- Step 3:** Measure in inches the dimensions of the countertop area for the project, marking the measurements on your rough drawing. Indicate the approximate location of any required cutouts for sinks and faucets, cooktops, etc. If your project includes a backsplash, please indicate where you would like the backsplash by drawing a double line along the length of countertop.
- *When measuring, it is best to round up to the nearest ½ inch for pricing purposes.*
- Step 4:** Mark each countertop (Top 1, Top 2, etc.)
- Step 5:** Indicate rounded corners and any special details if desired
- Step 6:** Indicate desired brand (Cambria, Corian®, etc), color and any other information that will help us quote your project as accurately as possible.
